

Busy Season Planned by Little Theatre

Chilliwack's Little Theater organization has a full and busy winter season in prospect with four one-act plays and one major production mapped out.

Officers have been elected, with Hilda Nuttall as president. Miss Nuttall was with the Everyman Theater on tour from Victoria to Winnipeg last year. Secretary-treasurer Eva Kerr has been with the local organization for some time.

Aims of the club are to promote interest in the community theater; present a chance for individuals to get practical experience in the theater; raise money toward scholarships at the Vancouver Summer School of the Theater and eventual presentation of local radio plays.

Largest production this season will be "Ladies In Retirement," a three-act mystery by Edward Percy and Reginald Denham, which was a 1940 Broadway success.
