DEHVA MOTTAGHIAN – Lavender

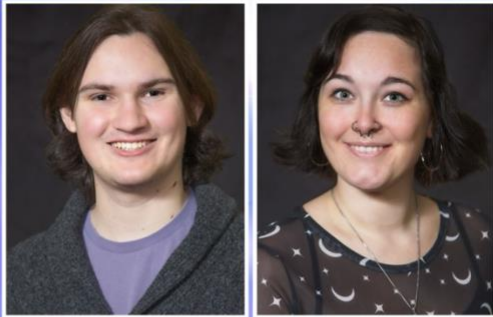
